ATHLETE SELECTION PROCEDURES
2008 World Youth Championship
July 8 - 13, 2008
Monterrey, Mexico

- I. **DEFINITIONS** – The following common definitions shall apply to this Team Selection Procedure:
- A. Competition: The “Competition” shall mean the 2008 FINA World Youth Championships to be contested July 8-13, 2008, in Monterrey, Mexico.
 - B. Available Swimmer: "Available Swimmer" shall mean a swimmer who (i) qualifies for the Team in an Event according to this Procedure and remains available through the Competition, (ii) satisfies all the FINA, World Anti-Doping Agency (WADA), United States Anti Doping Agency (USADA) and USA Swimming applicable eligibility requirements, (iii) accepts the invitation to become a member of the Team when that invitation is offered by USA Swimming, (iv) agrees to swim in the Event for which he/she qualifies, and (v) has not attended university. If a swimmer does not satisfy these requirements, then he or she is not considered an Available Swimmer.
 - C. World Rankings: “World Rankings” shall refer to the world rankings will be based on the 2007 swimnews.com world rankings form January 1, 2007- December 31, 2007, and the 2008 swimnews.com world ranking from January_1, 2008- June 1, 2008. Each swimmer's time from that Event of the Qualifying Competition will be used in determining the next available swimmer.
 - D. Doubles: “Doubles” shall refer to the instance when one swimmer qualifies to compete in two or more different swimming Events at the Competition.
 - E. Event: “Event” shall refer to competitions held in long course meters only.
 - F. Head Coach: Unless otherwise indicated, "Head Coach" shall refer to the head coach of the Team.
 - G. National Team Head Coach: "National Team Head Coach" shall refer to the USA Swimming National Team Head Coach, or his designee.
 - H. Qualifying Competition: “Qualifying Competition” shall mean the 2008 U.S. Olympic Team Trials – Swimming, to be held in Omaha, Nebraska, June 29 - July 6, 2008.
 - I. Swim Offs: “Swim Offs” may be held at the Qualifying Competition for the sole purpose of determining priority selection order. They are put in place to determine ties between athletes in the same qualifying event and are a one time opportunity to resolve the tie for placement on the team. The time from the swim off will NOT count towards selection to the Team.
 - J. Team: "Team" shall mean the 2008 FINA World Youth Championships Team announced by USA Swimming on July 7, 2008.

II. SELECTION SYSTEM

- A. Selection Eligibility. To be eligible for selection to the Team, a swimmer must be eligible under all applicable rules of FINA, the U.S. Anti-Doping Agency (USADA), and USA Swimming at the time of selection; must be a citizen of the United States; must hold a current passport at the time of the Qualifying Competition, through January 1, 2009; must be eligible to represent the United States at the Competition; and must be a registered athlete member in good standing of USA Swimming.
- B. Other Requirements.
1. All swimmers selected to the Team must meet the FINA age requirements as of December 31, 2008. All male athletes selected to the team must be born in 1990, 1991, 1992 or 1993. All female athletes must be born in 1991, 1992, 1993 or 1994. If an athlete who has attended university they are not eligible.
 2. All swimmers selected to the Team will be required to comply with all applicable rules and requirements of FINA, WADA, USADA, and USA Swimming. Specifically, and without limitation, each swimmer selected to the Team shall:
 - a. Sign and abide by the USA Swimming Comprehensive Honor Code, Authorization, Waiver and Release, and Commitment Declaration (see Attachment A) and conform to all USA Swimming policies and protocols regarding Team preparation and participation.
 - b. Allow USA Swimming and its sponsors to use a swimmer's likeness, photograph and/or image as part of a "National Team" marketing campaign, provided that USA Swimming and/or the sponsor's use (i) includes the likenesses, photographs and/or images of at least four individuals as part of the National Team, (ii) promotes USA Swimming and/or the National Team, or the sponsor's sponsorship of USA Swimming and/or the National Team; and (iii) does not state or imply any endorsement by any swimmer of any products or services.
 3. Athletes who have competed in a high level National Team competition (Olympic Games, World Championships, Pan Pacific Championships, Pan American Games, World University Games, Short Course World Championships, and Japan International Grand Prix) will not be considered for the Team.

C. Team Selection-Making and Filling the Team.

1. Team Size. The maximum allowable Team size is 13 men and 13 women. The actual Team size will be determined once the selection criteria have been implemented. For purposes of this Procedure, the men's and women's components of the Team shall be considered separately.
2. Performance Criteria for Team Selection. Performances in the Events at the Qualifying Competition will be prioritized as follows for each gender to fill the Team to a maximum of 13. Only swimmers who qualify via the priority set forth below are eligible for selection to the Team. Swimmers not qualifying via this priority will not be eligible to be selected to the Team.
3. The Team for each gender shall be selected based on the following priority:
 - Priority #1. The highest placing Available Swimmer in each Event at the Qualifying Competition will be invited onto the Team. Time trials will not be considered. Each swimmer shall either accept or deny the invitation and if the invitation is accepted, the accepting swimmer shall be named to the Team. In the event that a swimmer denies the invitation, the next highest placing Available Swimmer in that event shall be invited and given the opportunity to accept or deny the invitation. This process shall continue until a swimmer is selected to the Team for each Event.
4. Vacant Team Positions Due to Doubles. If the above performance criteria for Team selection results in a Team of less than thirteen (13) men or thirteen (13) women because certain Team members qualify for selection in more than one event, the remaining members of the Team shall be selected as follows in priority order (this criteria is applied separately for each gender):
 - i. After the first Double by an Available Swimmer, the next highest finishing Available Swimmer in the 100 or 200 Freestyle will be selected to the Team. The Available Swimmer with the highest World Ranking of these two athletes (in these two events) will be named to the Team.
 - ii. After the second Double by an Available Swimmer, the athlete who was not selected in II, C, 4, i (above), in the 100 or 200 Freestyle, will be selected to the Team.
 - iii. After the third Double by an Available Swimmer, the Available Swimmer with the highest World Ranking in his/her event, excluding the 100 and 200 Freestyle events, will be chosen. This process will occur until the Team has been filled.
 - iv. FINA rules allow up to two (2) competitors per country per individual event.

4. **Unfilled Individual Events.** As FINA rules allow up to two (2) competitors per country in each individual event, all swimmers who are named to the Team shall be eligible for any unfilled positions for the events at the Championships under the following procedures:

Any unfilled positions in Olympic Events shall be filled by the Team member who has swum the fastest time in such event during January 1, 2007 through July 6, 2008. The times to be considered must be long course meters.

For non-Olympic individual events at the Competition (M/W 50 Butterfly, M/W 50 Backstroke, M/W 50 Breaststroke, Men's 800 Freestyle and Women's 1500 Freestyle), athletes who are already on the Team will be named in these events according to two priorities:

Priority #1 - The first opportunity will be given to those athletes who have qualified for the Team in the events listed below:

<u>First Offer to Those on Team In:</u>		<u>Non-Olympic Event</u>
Men's/Women's 100 Butterfly	for	Men's/Women's 50 Butterfly
Men's/Women's 100 Backstroke	for	Men's/Women's 50 Backstroke
Men's/Women's 100 Breaststroke	for	Men's/Women's 50 Breaststroke
Women's 800 Free	for	Women's 1500 Free
***Men's 400 and 1500 Free	for	Men's 800 Free

*** The athletes in the men's 400 and 1500 free (long course meters) who have the highest world ranking from their swims that qualified them for the team, according to the world rankings based on swimnews.com as of June 1, 2008, will be offered the first opportunity to swim the men's 800 free.

- D. **Decreasing Team Size.** If the prioritization procedures described above result in a list of either more than 13 male or more than 13 female swimmers, then the swimmers of each gender shall be ranked and selected to the Team according to the following system:

1. **Breaking a Tie.**

- a. **Tie in Same Event.** In the instance where there is tie between two or more swimmers in the same event, a swim-off to break the tie will be held in that event on the day the tie occurred. The actual time of the swim-off will be determined by the National Team Head Coach.
- b. **Tie in Different Events.** In the instance where a tie between two or more swimmers in different Events occurs for the final position(s) on the Team, pursuant to the World Rankings from swimnews.com as of June 1, 2008, the tie will be broken as follows:
 - (1) Each swimmer's best performance swum in their Event at the Qualifying Competition will be rated according to the most recent FINA Long Course Performance Ratings and the swimmer(s) with the highest rating shall be selected to the final position(s) on the Team.

- (2) If this does not break the tie, then each swimmer's best performance swum in their Event at the Qualifying Competition will be converted into a ratio, using the Qualifying Competition time as the denominator, and the World Record for that Event at the beginning of the Qualifying Competition as the numerator, and the swimmer(s) with the highest percentage shall be selected to the final position(s) on the Team.
- (3) If this does not break the tie, the fastest time swum by each swimmer in their Event during the period January 1, 2007 through and including June 1, 2008 will be ranked according to the swimnews.com, and the swimmer with the highest ranking will be added to the Team.
- (4) If this fails to break the tie, the tie will be broken by random draw.

III. ENTRY ADJUSTMENTS

A. Adjustments to the Team after July 7, 2008.

If, for any reason, an additional Team position shall become vacant after July 7, 2008, no additional members will be added to the Team.

According to FINA rules, each federation is only allowed two (2) swimmers per individual event. If an individual event has an opening, athletes already on the team will be given the option of filling vacant positions. This decision will be left up to the Head Coach in conjunction with the National Team Head Coach.

IV. DISCRETIONARY SELECTION

A. Discretionary selection will not be used for any swimmers in individual Olympic Events from the Qualifying Competition.

However, all swimmers who are nominated to the Team shall be eligible for selection to any and all relays to be held at the Competition. The Head Coach, in consultation with the Assistant Coaches and National Team Head Coach or his designee, shall select the swimmers for each relay conducted at the Competition. In selecting the relay teams, the Head Coach, in consultation with the Assistant Coaches and National Team Head Coach or his designee shall consider all available information, including but not limited to each Team Member's Qualifying Competition performances (including preliminary times, time trials, and relay lead-off times), past relay performances, past relay reaction times, relay exchange experience, personal best performances, Championships Event schedules, individual workload, other recent results and performances, consistency of performances, fatigue, health, fitness levels, training preparation, participation in relay training camps, scientific evaluation, attitude and team chemistry. Selection of swimmers for relays shall not be subject to challenge.

Once Individuals are selected to the team, they will only be guaranteed to swim the event for which he/she qualifies for the Team. All other entries are subject to

the National Team Head Coach and the FINA World Youth Championships Head Coach approval. Each swimmer will only be allowed to swim up to two individual events per day based on schedule.

V. DISMISSAL FROM TEAM

- A. Any swimmer may be dismissed from the Team at any time following an appropriate hearing if (i) the swimmer violates any of the applicable FINA, USA Swimming or other rules and regulations applicable to the Team or its members, including without limitation applicable Codes of Conduct; or (ii) the National Team Head Coach or his designee, in consultation with the Head Coach, the USA Swimming Olympic International Operations Committee (OIOC) Chairman and the USA Swimming Athletes' Executive Vice President, determines that the swimmer is unable or unwilling to maintain a training regimen that is necessary for peak performance in the Championships.

VI. WITHDRAWAL FROM TEAM

- A. Any swimmer may withdraw from the Team at any time due to injury or illness, as certified by a USA Swimming Physician in consultation with USA Swimming (represented by the National Team Head Coach, Head Coach and Athlete Advisory Representative), which prevents the swimmer from full participation in the Competition.

VII. CHALLENGE

- A. Any challenge to these Procedures or any decision made pursuant to or in connection with these Procedures shall be handled as follows: 1) if such challenge relates to an alleged violation of a technical rule, it shall be handled according to the procedure set forth in Part One of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations (can be found at usaswimming.org); 2) if such challenge relates to an alleged violation of the National Team Honor Code, it shall be handled according to the procedure set forth in Section 8 of the USA Swimming Olympic International Operations Procedures Manual ("OIOC Procedures Manual," can be obtained from the National Team Division); and 3) if such challenge does not relate to an alleged violation of a technical rule or an alleged violation of the National Team Honor Code, it shall be handled according to USA Swimming's Hearing Procedure set forth in Part Four of the USA Swimming Rules and Regulations. Any hearing required in order to resolve a challenge shall take place on an expedited basis, if necessary, in order to resolve the challenge in sufficient time for Team selection to be finalized by a relevant deadline.

VIII. TRYOUT SITES AND EVENTS FOR NAMING TEAM MEMBERS

- A. The Qualifying Competition for naming the Team to the Competition pursuant to Section II.C.3 is the 2008 U. S. Olympic Team Trials - Swimming.

IX. DATE OF ENTRY SUBMISSION

- A. USA Swimming will submit all entries for the Championships on July 7, 2008.

X. ASSEMBLY, TRAINING AND COMPETITION

- A. Athletes nominated to the Team will be required to assemble, train, compete and remain with the Team throughout the Competition. Specific dates/locations of mandatory assembly, training and competition (subject to change) are:

XI. PUBLICITY/DISTRIBUTION OF PROCEDURES

- A. These Procedures, when approved, will be published on the USA Swimming Web site, usaswimming.org. Additionally, the Procedures will be distributed at the 2008 U.S. Olympic Team Trials at the general meeting.

XII. INTERNATIONAL DISCLAIMER

- A. These selection criteria are based on the latest information available to USA Swimming and are based on FINA and USA Swimming rules and regulations as presently known and understood. Any change in the selection procedures caused by a change in FINA or USA Swimming rules and regulations or other unforeseen circumstances will be distributed to the affected athletes immediately.

HONOR CODE

As a participant in any event, competition or activity conducted by United States Swimming, Inc. ("USA Swimming"), or in which I am representing USA Swimming, or for which I am selected by USA Swimming to attend at any time during 2008 (collectively, the "Event"), I, _____, understand and will comply with the following guidelines as set forth by USA Swimming and the Olympic International Operations Committee regulations at all times during each Event.

1. The possession or use of alcohol, tobacco products or controlled substances by any athlete or staff member participating in the Event is prohibited throughout the duration of the trip (until the team has officially disbanded).
2. Curfews established by the staff will be adhered to each day of the training camp and at the competition.
3. Team members and staff will attend all team functions including meetings, practices, exhibitions, press conferences, competitions, etc., unless otherwise excused or instructed by the head coach or National Team Head Coach or National Team Managing Director or other person designated by USA Swimming.
4. To ensure the propriety of the athletes and to protect the staff, there will be no male athletes in female athlete's rooms, and no female athletes in male athlete's rooms. There will be a team room provided for relaxation and recreation whenever possible.
5. Team members and staff will comply with USA Swimming and United States Olympic Committee uniform requirements. Details of this policy will be further explained at the beginning of the training camp or competition.
6. Team members and staff will refrain from any illegal or inappropriate behavior that would detract from a positive image of USA Swimming and its Event participants or be detrimental to its performance objectives.
7. Team members will display proper respect and sportsmanship toward coaches, officials, administrators, fellow competitors and the public.
8. USA Swimming will negotiate the rights of access to participants in the Event. Once an organization has negotiated these rights with USA Swimming, the following shall occur:
 - a. In the not-for-profit mode, Event participants and staff will comply with the USA Swimming request. These are considered to be promotion opportunities for the sport of swimming, to include but not limited to exhibition and promotional appearances. Any request for team or staff appearances will have the prior approval of the head coach or National Team Head Coach/National Team Managing Director or other person designated by USA Swimming.
 - b. In the for-profit mode, USA Swimming will have negotiated a set fee to include all Event participants and staff. All members will be asked if they wish to participate under these terms and financial arrangements. They may then: 1) Decline to participate, 2) Negotiate a higher fee directly with the for-profit

- organization; 3) Participate at the scale set by USA Swimming. Coaches, managers and athletes will all be included under these terms.
9. Any additional guidelines for the participants in the Event will be established as needed by the National Team Head Coach & General Manager/National Team Managing Director or other person designated by USA Swimming.

IMPLEMENTATION:

1. All team and staff are apprised in writing of this policy. Signature of this document constitutes unconditional agreement to comply with Honor Code of USA Swimming.
2. USA Swimming shall have the right to establish and use one or more systems to determine if all aspects of the policy have been followed by team and staff members.
3. Failure to comply with the Honor Code as set forth in this document may result in disciplinary action under the provisions of Section 8, USA Swimming-OIOC Policy Manual.

Such discipline may include, but may not be limited to: 1) Dismissal from the team and immediate return home at the athlete's expense ; 2) Disqualification from one or more events, or all events of competition; 3) Disqualification from future USA Swimming and international competition; 4) Financial penalties.

Any appeal following any disciplinary action shall be in accordance with Part Four of USA Swimming Rules and Regulations.

General Acknowledgement & Acceptance

I, _____, hereby acknowledge that all information and signatures on this form are applicable to my participation in the Event.

Oath of Eligibility

I declare that I am eligible and in good standing with regulations laid down by USA Swimming, the International Federation for Amateur Swimming (FINA), and the International Olympic Committee (IOC). I also declare I am not under suspension or disciplinary action imposed for use of illegal drugs or other athlete regulation infractions. I agree to sign additional documents to this effect when required to do so by USA Swimming, the USOC, or the local organizing committee.

I certify that, to the best of my knowledge and belief, I am in good physical condition and have no disease or injury that would impair my performance in this activity and agree that while a participant in this activity, I will keep myself in top physical condition and retain my eligibility status.

I agree to notify USA Swimming immediately upon any change to my eligibility, any disciplinary action, or any change in my physical condition that would result in the declarations and certifications becoming untrue with respect to any Event.

Doping

I understand that it is the policy of USA Swimming to discourage and prevent the use of prohibited doping substances and prohibited doping methods. I also understand that it is my responsibility to ensure that no prohibited substance enters my system. The FINA Anti-Doping Rules are available online and from USA Swimming. I know that I can call the USADA Drug Reference Line (1-800-233-0393) or check at the Drug Reference Online (www.usantidoping.org/dro) to check the status of all medications and substances I am currently using, and to satisfy any questions or concerns that I may have about medications and prohibited substances and methods.

I do not currently engage in, nor do I intend to use any prohibited substances and methods. I acknowledge that the use of prohibited substances or prohibited methods may subject me to disqualification and other sanctions imposed by USADA, FINA or IOC.

Drug Testing

I understand that testing organizations (USADA, FINA, WADA, etc.) will conduct drug testing on athletes during and outside of competition. By participating in the Event, I hereby consent to and authorize the testing organizations (USADA, FINA, WADA, etc.) to test me for prohibited substances and prohibited methods at any time. I further acknowledge and agree that my refusal to participate in a drug test may subject me to disqualification and sanctions, the same as if I had tested positive for a prohibited substance.

I hereby authorize USA Swimming to include the results of any drug testing of me in the published statistics for drug testing and to include my name in the list of athletes who have been drug tested, which USA Swimming publishes on their website. In the event I refuse to submit to a drug test or a drug test has a positive result, I recognize that I am subject to the adjudication processes established by the US Anti-Doping Agency (USADA) and FINA, because of my refusal or positive test.

Authorization & Event Promotion

I agree to be filmed and photographed by the official photographer(s) and network(s) of USA Swimming under the conditions authorized by USA Swimming and give the Event organizers the right to use my name, picture, likeness, and biographical information before, during and after the period of my participation in these activities to promote the activity in which I participate or to promote the success of the team on which I compete.

I understand and agree not to use or authorize use of pictures of myself in the uniforms and equipment provided by USA Swimming for the purpose of trade, without the consent of USA Swimming. I agree not to use medals or photos, portraits or film of myself with the medals, which I receive for my performance, for the purpose of trade. Furthermore, it is agreed that I shall return these uniforms and equipment, bearing USA Swimming logos and marks, if and when requested.

Authorization for Medical Services

I hereby give consent for USA Swimming to provide or obtain for me medical care and treatment and emergency medical services for any injuries arising in any manner from my participation in the Event. Additionally, I hereby agree that, in the event I elect to

obtain any of these services or treatments from any sources other than that provided or obtained by USA Swimming, I shall accept full and complete responsibility.

I further authorize release of any medical information necessary to process a claim for accident/medical payment insurance for an injury or illness incurred while I am participating as a member of the USA Swimming delegation in the Event.

Risk of Serious Injury

I understand and appreciate that my participation in the Event and in the sport of swimming carries a risk of serious injury, including permanent paralysis or death. I voluntarily and knowingly recognize, accept and assume this risk.

WAIVER & RELEASE

In consideration of allowing me to participate in this activity, I hereby release and hold harmless USA Swimming, members of its board of directors, and its officers, employees, members, volunteers, other participants, and agents (collectively, the "Released Parties"), of and from, and do discharge and waive, any and all claims, demands, losses, damages, and liabilities that I may have or sustain with respect to any and all damage and/or injury, of any type, arising out of my participation in the Event and any USA Swimming activity.
