1. Must have completed 10th, 11th, or 12th grade.
 2. Must be a USA Swimming member athlete.
 3. Must have participated in an individual event in the appropriate year in:

Portland, Ore.
 - 2005 Open Water National Championships
Fort Myers, Fla.
 - 2005 Speedo Champions Series (summer sectionals)
 - 2005 ConocoPhillips National Swimming Championships
Irvine, Calif.
 - 2005 Junior Swimming Championships
Irvine, Calif.
 - 2005 U.S. Open Swimming Championships
Auburn, Ala.
 - 2006 Speedo Champions Series (spring sectionals)
 - 2006 Spring Championships
Federal Way, Wash.
- Relay-only swimmers do not qualify.
4. Must have a minimum 3.5 grade point average on a 4.0 scale.

SELECTION METHOD

1. Must be nominated by a USA Swimming member or coach.
2. GPA for academic subjects: History/Social Science, English, Mathematics, Laboratory Science, Foreign Language, Arts— Visual/Performing and Computer Science. Grades in Honors (H), Advanced Placement (AP), and International Baccalaureate (IB) courses receive one extra grade point.
3. 4.0 GPA is the maximum GPA awarded.

SCORING FORMULA

1. Points system adds points awarded for GPA and for highest place achieved in championship competition.
2. Points are only assigned to letter grades; + and - are not considered.
3. Points awarded for placing in ConocoPhillips National Swimming Championships competition will be weighted by a 1.5 multiplier; points awarded for placing in the Spring Championships will be weighted by a 1.35 multiplier; points awarded for placing in the Junior Championships will be weighted by a 1.30 multiplier; points awarded for placing in the U.S. Open will be weighted by a 1.25 multiplier; points awarded for placing in Speedo Champions Series (sectional meets) will not be weighted; points awarded for placing in the US Paralympics Swimming National Championships and Open Water National Championships will be weighted by a 0.75 multiplier.

AWARDS

1. Three certificates to be awarded to each individual achieving Scholastic All-America status (one for the athlete, one for the school and one for the USA Swimming club).
2. A special pin to each individual earning a 4.0 GPA.
3. A special award to each individual named to the Scholastic All-America team three times.
4. Outstanding Achiever recognition is given to each individual who places first at the National Championships and maintains a 4.0 GPA.
