Rules: This is a timed finals meet for the top-ranked IMX swimmers aged 11 to 14 in the region. Swimmers will compete in single-year age divisions and will compete in all of the specified IMX events throughout the weekend:

11-year olds and 12-year olds will compete in
500 Free
100 Back
100 Breast
100 Fly
200 IM

13-year olds and 14-year olds will compete in
500 Free
200 Back
200 Breast
200 Fly
200 IM
400 IM

Age on the first day of the meet will determine a swimmer's age division. Swimmers will be entered and seeded in each event according to their short course times for that event. Girls' events (odd-numbered events) will be swum in Pool A; boys' (even-numbered) events will be swum in Pool B. There will be no relays. Fly-over starts will be used. Note that swimmers may scratch events, but that a scratch eliminates a swimmer from contention for awards.

Eligibility: This meet is open to all USA Swimming registered athletes from the designated LSC's aged 11 to 14 years, who have met the IMX score requirements. Swimmers qualify for the meet by having met the IMX minimum point total during the previous winter (short course season of 2008-9), summer (long course meters season of 2009) or in the portion of the short course season directly preceding the meet (fall of 2009), as follows:

[10-year old girls	2100 points]*
[10-year old boys	2000 points]*
11- 12-year old girls	2100 points
11- 12-year old boys	2000 points
13- 14-year old girls	2100 points
13- 14-year old boys	2000 points

Qualifying IMX point totals need to be confirmed through the USA Swimming Website (click on "Time/Time Standards," then click on "Find Your IM Extreme Challenge Ranking").

Please note that many swimmers attending the meet will have achieved their qualifying IMX totals while swimming in younger age groups, and would have had to meet the point minimum for those younger age groups.

* Also note that while there are no 10 and Under age groups or swimmers at this meet, many swimmers competing as eleven-year olds may have qualified as ten-year olds; in that case, girls would have had to score 2100 or higher, boys 2000 or higher.

Warm-up and Start Times:

Friday afternoon: Warm-up 3:00 p.m. Meet begins 4:00 p.m.

Saturday morning: Warm-up 6:30 a.m. Meet begins 8:00 p.m.

Saturday afternoon: Warm-up 2:30 p.m. Meet begins 4:00 p.m.

Sunday morning: Warm-up 6:30 a.m. Meet begins 8:00 a.m.

Note that for the final 20 minutes of the warm-up sessions, there will be separate lanes designated for dive starts and pacing.

Also, separate warm-up and warm-down lanes will be provided throughout each session of the meet.

Coaches' Meeting: A coaches' meeting will be held at 3:15 on Friday afternoon. In addition, we will have a brief debriefing session at the end of the final session Sunday to discuss the format and flow of the meet.

Entries: Swimmers should enter with their current best short course times, irrespective of the course in which their best or qualifying IMX point total was achieved, and irrespective of when they achieved their qualifying score. Entries should be made with Hy-tek Team Manager entry file.

Entry deadline: Entries are due by 12 midnight PST, Friday, November 13, 2009, but times may be updated until 12 midnight PST, Friday, November 27, 2009.

Entry fees: Swimmers enter all the events offered for their age bracket; the entry fee for all events is \$ 30.00 total. In addition, there will be a \$5.00 surcharge for each swimmer to help allay pool rental costs.

Mail entries: A hard copy of the entries, along with a check for the entry fees, must be received by Friday, November 27, 2009.

Scoring: Scoring for this meet will be based upon the single-age Hy-Tek IMX scores. Each time will be given a point value; a swimmer's scores from all events will be combined for an overall IMX point total. Disqualifications or scratches will receive zero points. Scoring and awards will be determined according to single-year age groupings and according to the swimmers' IMX totals (i.e., no awards for individual events).

Awards: Distinctive USA Swimming IMX plaques will be awarded to the top sixteen swimmers in each single-year age bracket and sex (e.g., sixteen awards for 11-year old girls, sixteen awards for 11-year old boys, etc.). Team awards 1st thru 3rd place.

Apparel: There will be t-shirts, sweat-shirts, etc. with the distinctive IMX Challenge logo available for purchase.

Safety: Current Oregon Swimming safety guidelines will be strictly enforced.
