National Certification Sub-Committee

Administers the National Officials Certification Program by:

- Reviewing and approving Officials Qualifying Meets (OQMs) for national evaluation. Works with subcommittee chair to review meet information and assess qualifications of nominated evaluators from pre approved lists or from research.
- Maintaining and developing the Officials Tracking System (OTS)
 - National program – in operation
 - tracking participation in all “National Championship” level meets
 - monitoring input from other OQMs
 - defining and implementing needed enhancements
 - develop and maintain training and operational documentation
 - LSC program – in development
 - defining OTS modifications for enhanced LSC use
 - implementing selected modifications
 - develop and maintain training and operational documentation
 - Work with USA Swimming staff and IT support vendor to maintain, troubleshoot and enhance the system
- Maintaining a list of qualified National Evaluators for the various positions and levels of certification
- Developing and maintaining an evaluators training program
- Reviewing and processing applications for advancement to, and recertification at, National Certification levels
- Reviewing, updating, and drafting certification guidelines, aids, manuals, and forms.
- Reviewing program annually and submit recommendations to the National Officials Committee.
