## Job Description

The application comes to me. I check meet results to make sure the times are correct and the other info needed. I make a copy and send the info to Headquarters (Chelsey Walden). National Office sends out certificates and pin to the recipient. All National (International - when US team is involved) are automatically recorded. I fill out the application myself and send it to Headquarters as a backup to make sure nothing was missed. These meets all have Nationally certified officials so I don't need the Referees' signature. Periodically I go to Top 16 lists to see if there are records that I have not yet received. (am working on four now - 2 Katie Hoff, and 2 Kate Ziegler that were not done at National meets). I keep a current list of the records and update it each month. This is it - a subcommittee is not needed for this. It could all be done at Headquarters if they do not want a double check anymore? I feel they have lots to do and having someone also keep tabs on this info helps.

### All-Star Relays

This is an interesting program. It has been hard to get times submitted except for a few LSC's. So I yearly go to the Zone All-Star meets and dig up new records. I send out the certificates provided by the National Office to the LSC's involved. They know the teams the swimmers came from which I do not. Other All-Star meets are eligible but only a few LSC's are involved. I recently went back into 80's results and came up with the names of the swimmers rather than just an LSC name. I found all but one and these are now posted on our website.
