2023 was an impactful year for the USA Swimming Foundation. Thank you to everyone who supported our mission to *Save Lives, Build Champions, and Impact Communities*. Below is an overview of what we accomplished in 2023. With your help, we can do even more in 2024!

**Saving Lives:** The Foundation awarded more than \$800,000 in learn-to-swim grants to programs across the country, positively impacting adults, children, and families. In May 2023, our learn-to-swim efforts were bolstered by Make a Splash Tour stops in Missouri, Texas and Louisiana.

**Building Champions:** We provided more than \$1.2 million in support to our National Team athletes as they accomplished tremendous success across the globe. American swimmers continue to inspire and motivate us all – highlighted by performances in Japan, Chile and Ireland.

**Impacting Communities:** The Foundation distributed \$145,000 to 29 recipients to assist in the creation of competitive swimming opportunities. With the support of OneAmerica Financial, the Foundation provided \$65,000 to eight HBCUs to reduce historical barriers to our sport. An additional \$108,500 fueled programming for sport development, which includes regional coaches clinics and diversity camps.
