



Technical Release Notes – April 28, 2026

This April release delivers a balanced set of enhancements focused on improving operational reliability, reporting capabilities, and core system workflows across USA Swimming platforms. Highlights include modernization of the National Meet Sanctioning process, foundational integration work supporting the transition to NCSI for Background Checks, expanded reporting and analytics capabilities, and a variety of production support and hot fix updates that improve stability and user experience. Together, these updates continue to strengthen the scalability, accuracy, and day-to-day usability of USA Swimming systems for members, coaches, administrators, and partners.

New Features

Background Check Integration - Migration to NCSI: This release introduces initial work to migrate USA Swimming's background check processes to NCSI (National Center for Safety Initiatives). These updates establish the foundation for a more standardized and integrated background check workflow, improving consistency, compliance, and long-term scalability.

National Meet Sanctioning Enhancements: This release includes significant updates to the National Meet Sanctioning process, introducing enhanced flexibility and improved configuration options for managing meet sanctions. These updates support both LSC and USA Swimming workflows, streamline navigation, and expand classification capabilities to better support meet setup and reporting.

Hot Fixes – Q2 2026

Several targeted hot fixes were implemented to address user account linking, validation issues, and data inconsistencies. These updates ensure improved reliability in account creation workflows and correct data handling across key systems.
